

Landmark surgery at PSRI



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New Delhi: A 33-year-old mother of three was admitted to PSRI recently. She had uncontrolled passage of urine immediately following delivery of her fourth child. She was operated upon at a Hospital in Baroda but the operation was abandoned due to excessive bleeding.

Eight months later, she was again operated upon in another hospital in Baroda but the defect could not be repaired and she continued to be in great distress due to continuous leakage of urine ultimately, consulted Dr Rajesh Taneja at PSRI one year later.

Dr Rajesh performed a proper examination and investigation and she was operated on Nov 5 and the abnormal trigonal VVF closed. Since surgery the patient has made a dramatic recovery and is free from the agony of continuous urinary leakage.
