2 kg tumour removed from man's adrenal gland

WITH A tumour weighing 2 kg removed successfully from his adrenal gland at the Pushpawati Singhania Research Institute, Mohan, 65, has got a new lease of life. Mohan was suffering from acute abdominal pain and wasn't responding favourably to any medicine.

"Pathological tests detected a tumour in his adrenal gland and further laboratory tests confirmed the cancer of cortex adenoma," said Dr Rajesh Taneja. Dr Taneja along with a team of doctors performed the operation on Mohan.

"Generally tumours of the abdomen are removed with laproscopic surgery, but because of its large size and odd position, we had to go an open surgical operation in Mohan's case," he added.

"After the surgery, the patient's hormone, biochemical and blood sugar level returned to normal and the adrenal gland is working normally again," Dr Taneja said.
